WHAT TO EXPECT

FEMALES // Do not wear or bring the following:

- T-shirt or other garments with offensive or inappropriate writing, language or pictures.
- Shirts or tops with plunging necklines.
- Tops that reveal undergarments.
- Bare-midriff clothing.
- Short mini-dresses/skirts.
- Short shorts, split-sided jogging shorts, or spandex shorts.

MALES // Do not wear or bring the following:

- T-shirt or other garments with offensive or inappropriate writing, language or pictures.
 - Short shorts, split-sided jogging shorts, or spandex shorts.
- Shirts must be worn at all times except in the cabin.
